





Full ASD Assessment

Our comprehensive clinic-based autism spectrum disorder (ASD) assessment is completed using the 'gold standard' in ASD assessment tools: the Autism Diagnostic Interview, Revised (ADI-R; parents) and the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS-2; child).

The clinic-based assessment is completed over three sessions, with the ADI-R and Feedback session currently taking place via telehealth and the ADOS-2 conducted in the clinic; the ADOS-2 and ADI-R assessments can be completed in any order, providing the correct ADOS-2 Module for the clinic session can be established based on age and language capacity without the psychologist's observation of the child. Fees include the test forms, administration, scoring, and a report. To claim a Medicare rebate, a valid referral from a paediatrician is required. Please note that you can only claim a rebate for the number of sessions assigned on your child's paediatric referral, and it is the family's responsibility to confirm their eligibility for a Medicare rebate (with Medicare directly) for any sessions.

Option 1: Three or four sessions referred by paediatrician:

^{*} If a diagnostic decision cannot be made following the clinic-based assessment, a telehealth consultation will be arranged with an appropriate educator or other professional. Time spent will be charge at \$160 per 30-minute block, or part thereof.

² Please note that Medicare will pay a rebate of \$89.65. Once you have reached your Medicare Safety Net, Medicare will pay a rebate of "80% of out-of-pocket costs or the EMSN benefit cap". If the "EMSN benefit cap" applies, the maximum rebate per session is capped at \$316.35. Please check your eligible rebate with Medicare.

Payments

Payments are required on the day via cash or card for clinic sessions. Please note that credit transactions incur a 2.2% surcharge that cannot be claimed through Medicare.

All fees not paid on the day will incur a 10% surcharge.

Cancellations

Cancellation fees apply for all cancelled (or non-attended) appointments:

0-24 hours notice: FULL fee
24-48 hours notice: 50% of fee
48 hours-7 days notice: 25% of fee

Cancellation fees will be waived if your appointment time is used by another family, or if your session can be rescheduled; please provide as much notice as possible so that we can help you to avoid cancellation fees.
